 - 3f Monitor "grassed waterways"
 - 4b Address shoreline issues with the beach clubs
 - 4d Evaluate and repair existing runoff and sediment control structures
 - 4e Reduce verified gully/ravine areas within riparian zone
 - 6a Streambank erosion and lateral recession rate monitoring
 - 6d Cropland roadside transect survey within entire watershed
 - 7a Repeat Shoreline Assessment
 - 7b Complete Stream Power Index for gulleys/ravines within the riparian zone
 - 7d Evaluate all streams, gullies and washes entering into the bays for runoff and erosion issues.
